English



English: In English students learn to communicate effectively through speaking, listening, reading, viewing and presenting. You can help at home by reading to your child every night and also listening to your child read every night. Take the time to make predictions about the text and ask questions about what happened in the text. Check if there are any words your child doesn't understand and explain them. It is important that reading at home is enjoyable. You can read more <u>here</u>. <u>Reading Eggs</u> logins are currently being rolled over and will be available soon.

Mathematics



Mathematics: In Stage 1, Mathematics provides students with knowledge, skills and understanding in *Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry*, and *Statistics and Probability.*

You can support your child at home by making maths part of everyday life.

- Do lots of counting and estimating at the shops, look at prices and compare.
- Look for patterns, count forwards and backwards, skip count, compare numbers and measurements.
- Read the time and look at the date on a calendar.
- Do lots of play-based maths is such as playing shops, card and dice games.

History and Geography Integrated Unit: Past in the **Present** Students will explore the history of our local area, learning to identify and describe significant people, events and places. They will examine the impact of technology on their daily lives and demonstrate developing historical inquiry and communication skills. Students in Stage 1 will follow the geographical inquiry process and use stories, maps, language and symbols to describe natural and man made features of places and the significance connections people have with places. 10

Homework

Homework will commence in Week 5. We encourage you to read with your child each day and record the titles of the books in their Home Reading Log. For every ten nights logged the student will receive a principal sticker. Texts can include Decodable and PM Readers brought home from school, books borrowed from the school or local library and personal books from your home bookshelf. Please try to read a range of fictional and non-fiction texts as well as poetry.

Students also have the option of engaging with differentiated hands on mathematics games and online activities via <u>Mathletics</u> and/or <u>Mathseeds</u>.
