## **Requirements for K6G 2024**

To ensure that your child is fully equipped for K6G, we have put together a list of items that will be needed for next year. Please make sure that all items are out of their packaging and labelled with your **child's name**.

**It is a good idea to keep this list handy and to replenish stationery stocks at the beginning of each new school term.** Your child's leftover equipment from 2023 will be sent home for topping up.

- Hat and raincoat each day
- Separate Recess and Lunch box, plus a small fruit break container
- 2x sets of coloured pencils (the basic colours)
- 2x yellow highlighters
- Textas
- Set of 3-4 whiteboard markers
- 2x each size of black Artline pen (0.4mm and 0.6mm tip)
- 2x black Artline 70 permanent marker (1.5mm tip)
- Medium pencil case
- Small headphones **labelled** for computers in a zip lock bag
- Pencil sharpener (enclosed kind is the best)
- 2x erasers
- 10-12 glue sticks (2-3 per term)
- Library bag
- OPAL card topped up with \$20 (these will be kept at school, ready for Nippers in Term 4)
- 10 lead pencils (2B if student has very light pressure when writing, HB if regular writing pressure) - please wait for Gail to assess at the start of Term 1 if you're unsure
- Large old shirt (to use as an art smock).

To contribute to the smooth running of the classroom, we would like each family to supply:

- 3x boxes of tissues
- 2x packets of disinfectant wipes
- 4x packets of baby wipes
- 2x refills of disinfectant hand soap (not foaming)
