Curriculum Reform

All K-6 classes are working with new English and Mathematics syllabi as part of NSW Department of Education's Curriculum Reform. The focus is in K-2 on building strong foundational skills for students in literacy and numeracy. English

The aim of English in Stage One is to enable students to understand and use language effectively. Students learn to appreciate, reflect upon and enjoy language and make meaning in ways that are imaginative, creative, interpretive, critical and powerful. Through the explicit instruction and integration of oral language, phonemic awareness, phonics, spelling, handwriting, decoding, reading and comprehension, students learn the foundational literacy skills needed to become confident communicators, critical and imaginative thinkers, and informed and active participants in society.

Mathematics

The aim of mathematics is to enable students to become confident users of mathematics, learning and applying the language of mathematics to communicate efficiently and effectively. They develop an increasingly sophisticated understanding of mathematical concepts and a fluency with mathematical processes that helps them to interpret and solve problems. Students make connections within mathematics and connect mathematical concepts with the world around them. They learn to understand and appreciate how mathematics is a relevant part of their lives.

Homework

In Term 1, homework for Stage One will involve reading each night. It is extremely important that you continue to listen to your child read each night even nwhen they can read independently. Please use your child's Home Reading Log to record what your child is reading at home. Students receive a Principal's Sticker for each ten nights of reading.

Online resources such as mathletics and reading eggs are currently being rolled over. Passwords will be sent home soon.
