

Sun Safety Procedures at Cromer PS

Classroom Practice

- Teachers, where possible, schedule outdoor activities outside of peak UV times (10-2pm AEST, 11-3 ADST).
- Outdoor activities are cancelled at teacher's discretion on days of extreme heat.
- Wherever possible teachers use shaded areas within the school for outdoor activities.

Sport, Carnivals and Excursions

- While PSSA may be cancelled due to extreme weather the Cromer PS principal may also cancel Cromer's participation where they deem it necessary.
- Students are encouraged to wear sunscreen and hats and stay in the shade wherever possible. The school is not able to provide sunscreen to students due to allergies etc.
- Sun safe expectations will be outlined in all sport and excursion notes and included in the Player and Parent's Code. Consequences for not complying will also be included in notes.
- Children who come to sport without a hat will be directed to a shaded area within sight of the supervising teacher. Their parents will be informed of this consequence via email from the sports teacher.
- Where possible venues for excursions and carnivals will have sufficient shaded areas. Where this is not possible shade tents will be utilised.

Playground

- Students are reminded to wear hats as they exit classrooms.
- Students without hats are directed to the Shaded Common.

Mufti- Days

- Students are required to wear hats and clothing that covers their shoulders when in mufti.

Curriculum

- Teachers use PDHPE lessons to promote the 'Sun Safe' message.
- School Executive routinely promote a Sun Safe message in the school's newsletter.
